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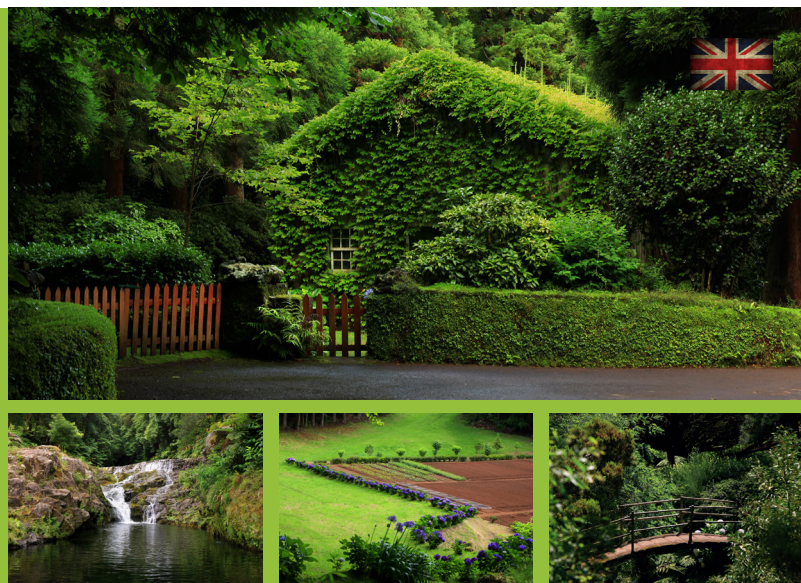

THE FOREST PARKS

The Forest Parks start to be the expression of a policy of agricultural policy, contained in the *Plan of Forest Settlement* dated from 1938. The first concrete signs of that policy would be presented more later in the *Plan of Resettlement Forest District of Ponta Delgada*, dated from 1948. Nowadays, the Forest Reserves constitute a business card of Azorean forest, taking as prime locations to showcase our natural resources, including species of native flora and exotic, huntable species, especially fish and action on the Forest Service Region. ... that for these common land were elaborated afforestation plans, serving as a genesis for the current Recreation Forest Reserves?

... there was a concern to maintain existing natural vegetation areas with the species of flora and fauna which are associated with allowing later the creation of Natural Forest Reserves?

... DRRF received in 1999 the "Henry Ford Prize for the conservation of nature" by having led the project entitled "Study and conservation of the Natural Heritage of the Azores – *Phyllula murina*"?

... nurseries of Forest Services produce 500 thousand of endemic plants per year?

... a plant of *Cryptomeria japonica* takes 2 years to produce in nursery?

... *Myrica faya*, *Frangula azorica*, *Prunus azorica* and *Draecena draco* takes an average of 45 days to germinate?
